

# 2009 New Varieties



**Boone**

Excellent disease resistance, including Rust, Common Blight, Halo Blight, Bacterial Brown Spot and Curly Top. Very uniform pod colour. Upright plant habit. Three- and four-sieve diameter and 5.25 inches in length. *(Courtesy of Harris Moran)*



**Crockett**

Round straight pods; intense deep green colour. Excellent disease resistance, including Rust, Common Blight, Halo Blight, Bacterial Brown Spot and Curly Top. Upright plant habit produces high yields of two- and three-sieve beans that pick clean. *(Courtesy of Harris Moran)*



**Hickok**

Produces 40 per cent three-sieve beans; medium dark green straight pods; 60 per cent four-sieve pods; upright plant habit, high pod set keeps beans off the ground. Resistant to Rust, Bean Common Mosaic. *(Courtesy of Harris Moran)*



**Pike**

Darker colour with 70 per cent three-sieve pods; upright plant that holds the pods off the ground; easy machine harvest; picks easy and clean. *(Courtesy of Harris Moran)*



**Delia**

78 days maturity; semi-domed head; medium to small heads; blue green colour; well adapted for bunching; good heat tolerance; for all season production. *(Courtesy of La Coop Uniforce)*



**Bajonet**

Green fresh market cabbage; resembles the fresh look, blue green colour of Bronco; round heads are 3-5 lbs; fancy wrapper leaves; high resistance to Fusarium yellows. *(Courtesy of Seedway)*



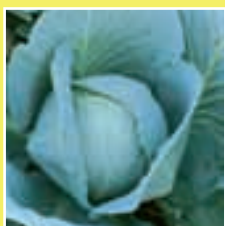
**Checkmate**

Early, green cabbage; 65 days; heads are uniform, round: 3-5 lbs, excellent flavour, fusarium yellows resistant. *(Courtesy of Seedway)*



**Han Jiang**

65 days; Chinese type hybrid; 2.3-3.0 kg heads; tolerant to bolting, tip burn, soft rot and DM. *(Courtesy of Norseco)*



**Novator**

110 days; late, storage-type; 6.5-9 lbs. heads; store very well; blue-green round heads; tolerant to internal blackening and fusarium. *(Courtesy of Stokes Seeds)*



**Resnic**

92 days; medium term storage cabbage; 2-2.5 kg head with good wrapper leaves; tolerant to fusarium yellows. *(Courtesy of Norseco)*



**Atlantis**

A new, 75-day, eastern melon from Sakata; round oval shape; excellent interior quality; firm; consistent high sugar content; use either as a shipper or farm market variety. *(Courtesy of Rupp)*



**Standford**

Berlicum type; for jumbo production; for both organic and mineral soils; cylindrical roots; 10 inches; strong attachment. *(Courtesy of La Coop Uniforce)*

## Sweet Baby Jane



Perfect for the baby carrot market; very uniform and smooth; blunt shape on slightly longer roots; dark orange colour; medium size tops; good attachment. (Courtesy of Stokes Seeds)

77 days; good vigour and uniformity; good head protection; best for fall production. (Courtesy of La Coop Uniforce)

## Novaria



77 days; nice self wrap; nice head; good tolerance to riceyness and hairiness; vigorous plant and good size potential. (Courtesy of La Coop Uniforce)

## UG 3705



56 days; monoecious, pickling variety; produces dark, firm, uniform fruit; tolerant to CMV, ZYMV, PM. (Courtesy of Norseco)

## Charming Pink



55 days; attractive, cylindrical fruit in a flashy pink colour with white flesh. (Courtesy of Norseco)

## Gretel



55 days; white miniature; AAS 2009 winner; clusters of 3-5 sweet, tender fruit; extended harvest period; adaptable to cultivation in pots. (Courtesy of Norseco)

## Lunch Lady



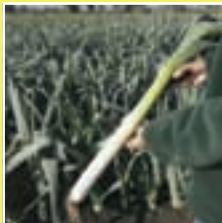

## Centennial

**Kaigaro**



100 days; early, large calibre storage onion; yellow with medium brown skin. (Courtesy of Norseco)

**Patterson**



110 days; long-term storage; very uniform bulbs; nice shape; medium bronze colour; good bolting, botrytis tolerance; high yield potential. (Courtesy of La Coop Uniforce)

**Tenshin**



100 days; long storage-type for muck or mineral soils; high yields; very uniform, hard round globe; excellent skin, thin neck and great colour; should provide high pack out for shipping or storage until May or June; strong tolerance to foliar diseases; slow to bolt when stressed. **Trailblazer**



60 days; early hybrid with dark and erect foliage; bunching variety; resistant to handling. (Courtesy of Norseco)

**TRI-5504**



XL-jumbo, glossy, dark green fruit; uniform; high percentage of USDA #1 packouts; vigorous plants; intermediate resistance to BLS 1,2,3,4. (Courtesy of Harris Moran)

**Allegiance**



Blocky, green-to-red sweet pepper; high yields of XL-jumbo smooth fruit; vigorous plant; excellent leaf coverage; resistance to BLS 1,2,3,5; intermediate resistance to TSWV, CMV, Pc. (Courtesy of Harris Moran)

**Declaration**



Produces high numbers of glossy, dark green, large-extra to large fruit; tall, erect, vigorous plant; good leaf coverage; extended harvest period; resistant to TMV, BLS 1,2,3,4. (Courtesy of Harris Moran)

**HM2641**



Dark green, glossy colour; fresh market variety; produces smooth, blocky, uniform, four-lobed fruit; large percentage of extra large; medium size plant; early maturity to red; multiple race BLS resistance. (Courtesy of Siegers Seed)

**Hunter**



Long, uniform, conical shaped Jalapeno; perfect for processing and fresh markets; large size, yield; early maturity; disease resistance. (Courtesy of Siegers Seed)

**New Park**



Jalapeno; performs well in low nighttime temperatures; highly concentrated, very productive fruit set; yields large, eye-appealing fruit; minimal corkiness; low anthocyanin production; exceptional setting abilities in warm and cold weather; typically early. ## Camaro



Stands up to powdery mildew; 20 to 23 lbs.; fruit is a medium-orange colour. (Courtesy of Seedway)

## Chucky



True soft-shelled pumpkin pie hybrid; excellent handle remains thick, solid for the entire sales and use season; excellent colour, size, shape; grows on a semi bush. (Courtesy of Siegers Seed)

## Super Freak Series

100 days; weighs 4-8 kg; dark green, round flat squash; firm, red, sweet flesh; winter variety. (Courtesy of Norseco)

## Speckled Hound

## Speckled Pup

## Goldi



An extra sugary, indeterminate yellow cherry tomato; uniform, firm 3/4 oz. fruit. (Courtesy of Seedway)

## Picus



Main season, determinate roma; fruit are large, uniform and blocky, maturing to a deep-red colour; medium to large, vigorous plant; good fruit cover; sets well in hot temperatures; resistant to ASC, F-1, F-2, GLS, TSWV and V-1. (Courtesy of Seminis)

## Primo Red



Produces high volumes of early, XL fruit; medium-sized, vigorous plant; responds well to high management environments; intermediate resistance to TSWV. (Courtesy of Harris Moran)

## Red Defender



Widely adapted variety; produces high yields; large-sized; has smooth shoulders; superior firmness; dark red colour; good shelf-life; resistant to V1, Fol US 1,2; Intermediate resistance to TSWV. (Courtesy of Harris Moran)

## Red Moon



63 days; hybrid; sweet fruit; nice texture; attractive red colour; resistant to TMV and to cracking; fruit grows in clusters; indeterminate plant habit. (Courtesy of Norseco)

## Crunchy Red



Triploid; meets fresh-cut standards; high Brix; appealing deep red colour; good shipping ability; external colour is medium green to medium dark green with green stripes; wide growing adaptability. (Courtesy of Harris Moran)

## Honey Bee



Personal size; yellow flesh; seedless; black rind contrasts with crisp solid lemon-yellow flesh; clean, sweet flavour; high yielding, 5 to 7 lbs. (Courtesy of Seedway)

## Ruby



Triploid melon; distinctive fade resistant rind pattern; crisp bright red flesh; small pips; well-defined flesh rind boundary. (Courtesy of Siegers Seed)

## Sorbet



Mid-size, seedless watermelon; sweet flesh; unique rind; early maturity; uniform size, 11-13 lbs; resistance to fusarium (race 1 & 3) and anthracnose (0,1). (Courtesy of Seedway)

High packouts; attractive, dark, glossy, fruit; small end-scar; open, upright plant; easy harvest; intermediate resistance to PM, ZYMV, WMV. (Courtesy of Harris Moran)

## Gold Prize



Brilliant yellow, straight neck with green stem; conventionally bred; high quality fruit with smooth skin; uniform shape; disease package against viruses. (Courtesy of Siegers Seed)

## Impact



High yields; early maturing; dark green fruit; very strong disease package. (Courtesy of Siegers Seed)

## Reward



High, early yielder; well adapted to double-row plantings; medium dark green colour; straight, cylindrical, long; small end scar; intermediate resistance to PM (Sf), ZYMV, WMV, CMV. (Courtesy of Harris Moran)
